Event organizers are excited to announce the 2025 Sustainability Plan, a comprehensive initiative to ensure environmentally conscious practices while delivering a safe, family-friendly event.

Sustainability Highlights

The Hyundai Air & Sea Show® is committed to minimizing environmental impact while enhancing the attendee experience. Sustainability measures for 2025 include:

- **Promoting Eco-Friendly Transportation:** Attendees are encouraged to ride bicycles or use public transportation to reduce carbon emissions.
- **Supporting Local Vendors:** The event will prioritize hiring local vendors to stimulate the Miami Beach economy and reduce transportation emissions.
- **Waste Management:** The event is working to implement a robust waste-sorting program.
- **Sustainable Catering Practices:** Partnering with our caterer to source environmentally responsible dry goods and reduce single-use plastics.
- **Post-Event Beach Cleanup:** A post-event beach sweep to ensure the beach remains pristine.
- **Eliminating Single-Use Plastics:** Continuing the longstanding tradition of no straws, stirrers, Styrofoam, or single-use plastics at the event.

What to Bring and What to Leave at Home

To help maintain a clean and safe environment, attendees are encouraged to:

Bring:

- Reusable water bottles
- Biodegradable sunscreen
- Personal items secured in eco-friendly bags

Leave at Home:

- Plastic bags and items that could litter the beach
- Papers or materials prone to being blown away
- Single-use plastics, including cutlery, straws, and Styrofoam

Public Safety Advisory

To ensure the safety and enjoyment of all attendees, the Hyundai Air & Sea Show® will enforce the following measures:

Marina Safety Information Bulletin (MSIB) Advisory: To maintain safety during the Hyundai Air & Sea Show®, a safety zone will be enforced in the waters off Miami Beach, Florida. This rule will be effective from 8:30 a.m. on May 23, 2025, until 6:00 p.m. on May 25, 2025, coinciding with the event's activities. The safety zone will encompass the waters of the Atlantic Ocean from approximately 0.5 miles east of Collins Park (25° 47'52"N, 080° 6'55"W) to South Pointe Park (25°45'50"N, 080°07'49"W), ensuring the safety of all participants and spectators. Unauthorized entry into the zone is prohibited without permission from the Captain of the Port Miami or a designated representative.

Traffic Information: In anticipation of increased traffic during the event, a traffic mitigation plan will be implemented from May 23rd to May 26th. Specific traffic flow adjustments will include restricted access points and enhanced police presence to ensure smooth traffic flow and safety for residents and visitors alike.

Parking Information: On-street parking restrictions will be enforced to facilitate traffic flow and ensure pedestrian safety. Additional parking garage locations and shuttle service details will be provided four weeks prior to the event. These services are designed to offer convenient parking and transportation options for Hyundai Air & Sea Show® attendees.

Staffing & Preparations: Miami Beach Police, along with local, state, and federal law enforcement partners, will work diligently to maintain public safety throughout the event. Enhanced staffing and measures will be in place to ensure a secure and enjoyable experience for all attendees.

Prohibited Items and Reminders: Attendees are reminded of prohibited items, especially **DRONES** and **HELIUM BALLOONS AND KITES**. Alcohol and smoking materials are also prohibited.

Additional Measures: The following additional measures may be imposed as necessary:

- Limitations may be placed on live or amplified music.
- The citywide suspension and closure of all or part of sidewalk café operations located in the MXE and CD-2 districts each night (including the removal of any sidewalk café furniture).
- Coolers, glass bottles, inflatable devices, tents, tables, and similar objects may be prohibited from public beaches.

Prohibited items at the Hyundai Air & Sea Show include:

- **DRONES**
- **HELIUM BALLOONS/BALLOONS OF ANY SORT**
- Alcohol and drugs
- Coolers in the preferred seating area
- Bicycles, in-line skates, and skateboards (in the Display Village)
- Litter/trash
- Plastic straws and Styrofoam (in any form)
- Tents or pop-up structures
- Smoking
- Weapons
- No pets allowed

Reminders:

- Drink plenty of water
- Wear sunscreen
- Wear your wristband to enter any/all restricted areas (media, preferred seating area...etc.)
