MIAMI BEACH (May 18, 2026) – The [Hyundai Air & Sea Show®](#), a proud Memorial Day Weekend tradition in Miami Beach, returns **May 23-24, 2026**, with an enhanced focus on sustainability and safety. As an official America250 event, the show is proud to join communities across the nation in commemorating 250 years of American independence — honoring the values of freedom, service, and patriotism that define this celebration.

#### Sustainability Highlights

The Hyundai Air & Sea Show® is committed to minimizing environmental impact while enhancing the attendee experience. Sustainability measures for 2026 include:

- **Promoting Eco-Friendly Transportation:** Attendees are encouraged to ride bicycles or use public transportation to reduce carbon emissions.
- **Supporting Local Vendors:** The event will prioritize hiring local vendors to stimulate the Miami Beach economy and reduce transportation emissions.
- **Waste Management:** The event is working to implement a robust waste-sorting program.
- **Sustainable Catering Practices:** Partnering with our caterer to source environmentally responsible dry goods and reduce single-use plastics.
- **Post-Event Beach Cleanup:** A post-event beach sweep to ensure the beach remains pristine.
- **Eliminating Single-Use Plastics:** Continuing the longstanding tradition of no straws, stirrers, Styrofoam, or single-use plastics at the event.

#### What to Bring and What to Leave at Home

To help maintain a clean and safe environment, attendees are encouraged to:

##### Bring:

- Reusable water bottles
- Biodegradable sunscreen
- Personal items secured in eco-friendly bags

##### Leave at Home:

- Plastic bags and items that could litter the beach
- Papers or materials prone to being blown away
- Single-use plastics, including cutlery, straws, and Styrofoam

#### Public Safety Advisory

To ensure the safety and enjoyment of all attendees, the Hyundai Air & Sea Show® will enforce the following measures:

**Marina Safety Information Bulletin (MSIB) Advisory:** To maintain safety during the Hyundai Air & Sea Show®, a safety zone will be enforced in the waters off Miami Beach, Florida. This rule will be effective from 8:30 a.m. on May 21, 2026, until 6:00 p.m. on May 24, 2025, coinciding with the event's activities.

The safety zone will encompass the waters of the Atlantic Ocean from approximately 0.5 miles east of Collins Park and continues (one half mile offshore. Starting at Point 1 in position 25°47'52" N, 080°6'55" W; thence southwest to Point 2 in position 25°45'40" N, 080°7'16" W; thence northwest to Point 3 in position 25°45'50" N, 080°07'49" W; thence north to Point 4 in position 25°47'56" N, 080°07'30" W; thence back to the origin at Point 1. All vessels, except event participants, are prohibited from entering, transiting, or anchoring within the restricted area. People swimming along the coastline will be permitted into the zone up to 150 feet from shore. A map of the restricted area is included below.

As a reminder, a slow-speed zone has been established for vessels less than 50 meters (164 feet) in length traveling through Fisherman's Channel and Port Miami's Main Ship Channel. **Traffic Information:** Protected residential zones for the Flamingo Park and South of Fifth neighborhoods will be in place each evening from 6 p.m. through 5 a.m. on Friday, May 22, Saturday, May 23 and Sunday, May 24 with barricades in place to restrict cut-through traffic in these residential areas. Flamingo Park and South of Fifth residents are encouraged to use Alton Road to enter and exit their neighborhood. There will be enhanced police presence in other surrounding neighborhoods. The Police Department will utilize and deploy fixed and mobile License Plate Readers (LPRs) throughout the city along with an LPR detail on the 5 Street and 41 Street corridors on Saturday, May 23 and Sunday, May 24 from 5 p.m. to 3 a.m. the following day.

Additionally, the city's traffic monitoring and management contractor will monitor major thoroughfares to detect incidents creating congestion based on available resources and equipment, including existing closed-circuit television and portable cameras in the city, the WAZE mobile application, portable variable message signs for traffic/event messaging, and modifications to traffic signal timing as needed to manage congestion. Traffic Monitors will operate 18 hours a day, from 7 a.m. to 1 a.m. each day, from Friday, May 22 through Sunday, May 24.

During hours when the traffic mitigation plan is in place, the Miami Beach Trolley will be enhanced and Miami-Dade County transit services will operate normally. The Transit App will be updated as needed to reflect service changes and important updates.

**Parking Information:** Effective Friday, May 22 at 9 p.m. through Monday, May 25 at 9 a.m., a high-impact flat parking rate of \$30 per vehicle for nonresidents and \$15 for residents will be imposed at all city parking garages in the Entertainment District. This includes parking garages at 7 Street and Collins Avenue, 12 Street and Washington Avenue, 13 Street and Collins Avenue as well as the Anchor Garage on 16 Street.

### **Free Parking Shuttles and Enhanced Miami Beach Trolley Service**

The city will provide free shuttle service to and from two designated event parking garage locations. Please look for the special parking shuttle identification signs prior to boarding. Parking shuttles will operate on Saturday, May 23 and Sunday, May 24 from 11 a.m. to 7 p.m., at intervals of approximately 15 to 20 minutes.

Designated free shuttle pick-up and drop-off locations are as follows:

- 42 Street garage: shuttle bus will serve trolley stop #219 at Sheridan Avenue and 41 Street.
- 17 Street, Pennsylvania Avenue, and the City Hall garages: shuttle bus will serve trolley stop #200 at 17 Street and Convention Center Drive.

All passengers using the free shuttle service will be dropped off at trolley stop #106 located on the west side of Washington Avenue between 11 and 12 streets. Passengers should use this stop for their ride back to the parking garages.

Alternatively, passengers can use the free Miami Beach Trolley service which will operate on an enhanced schedule, with two additional vehicles operating on the South Beach Loop and two additional vehicles assigned to the Collins Express Trolley to achieve an average service frequency of 13 to 15 minutes on both routes. The enhanced trolley service will operate from 11 a.m. to 7 p.m. on Saturday, May 23 through Sunday, May 24. Outside of the enhanced service, the Miami Beach Trolley will operate regular hours and service frequency.

### **Monument Island Closed to Boaters**

The city will close Flagler Monument Island to boaters over Memorial Day weekend due to a history of some boaters leaving significant litter behind. The uninhabited island will close starting on Friday, May 22 at 6 a.m. and will reopen at 6 a.m. on Tuesday, May 26.

**Staffing & Preparations:** Miami Beach Police will be working 10-hour overlapping shifts with an Alpha/Bravo staffing configuration. Several local, state and federal law enforcement partners will be assisting MBPD with public safety, including, but not limited to, the Florida Highway Patrol, Miami-Dade County Police and Miami-Dade Schools Police. Miami Beach Fire, Ocean Rescue, Code Compliance, Parking, Public Works, Sanitation, and Parks and Recreation will also have significantly enhanced staffing throughout the weekend.

**Prohibited Items and Reminders:** Attendees are reminded of prohibited items, especially **DRONES** and **HELIUM BALLOONS AND KITES**. Alcohol and smoking materials are also prohibited.

**Additional Safety Measures:** The following additional measures may be imposed as necessary:

- Limitations may be placed on live or amplified music.
- The citywide suspension and closure of all or part of sidewalk café operations located in the MXE and CD-2 districts each night (including the removal of any sidewalk café furniture).
- Coolers, glass bottles, inflatable devices, tents, tables, and similar objects may be prohibited from public beaches.

**Prohibited items at the Hyundai Air & Sea Show include:**

- **DRONES**
- **HELIUM BALLOONS/BALLOONS OF ANY SORT**
- Alcohol and drugs
- Coolers in the preferred seating area
- Bicycles, in-line skates, and skateboards (in the Display Village)
- Litter/trash
- Plastic straws and Styrofoam (in any form)
- Tents or pop-up structures
- Smoking
- Weapons
- No pets allowed

**Reminders:**

- Drink plenty of water
- Wear sunscreen

- Wear your wristband to enter any/all restricted areas (media, preferred seating area...etc.)

**Nicklaus Children’s Hospital Kids Zone:** Located on Ocean Drive between 14<sup>th</sup> Street and 14<sup>th</sup> Place next to Lummus Park, from 11 a.m. to 6 p.m. both Saturday and Sunday (May 23 and 24).
